- ca. 570 CE Birth of Muhammad in Mecca
- 610 Muhammad's first revelations
- 613 Muhammad begins public preaching
- 622 Hijrah: 1st year of Islamic calendar
- 630 Occupation of Mecca by Muslims
- 632 Death of Muhammad
- 661 Establishment of Umayyad Caliphate in Damascus [Origin of Sunni – Shi'ite split]
- 749 Abbasids seize Caliphate, transfer capital to Baghdad
- 945 End of Abbasid Caliphate
