Your final project consists of a project, a paper and a presentation. Your paper, which should be in the 5-10 page range should clearly explain what problem your project is addressing, how you have approached it, and why this is a promising approach. You should include references to previous work that relates to it - whether by addressing similar problems or by being a related design. You should have a clear functional description of how your project would look and be used, if it were to be fully implemented. Your paper should be amply illustrated with your designs. Some of you may choose to have a separate visual or interactive presentation of your work (the project) while others may incorporate the visual materials into the paper presentation. (Please keep the paper to 5-10 pages of text - if your paper is very heavily illustrated, it may be much longer in actual pages).

The class presentation should cover the same material, in a presentation mode. You will each have 20 minutes to present.
